GUIDELINES

Text

The text should be submitted as “Word file” (PC format .doc).

The text should not exceed 5000 words (excluding tables).

FONTS: Please use Times New Roman, 12 pt for the text.

Reference style

- Citations may be made directly (or parenthetically)
- *Text:* All citations in the text should refer to:
 - The author's name (without initials, unless there is ambiguity) and the year of publication;
 - In case of one author: (Baroz, 1980)

Bibliography:

 - In case of two authors: (Thy and Xenophontos, 1991).

 - In case of three or more authors (first author et al., year): (Gomez et al., 2002)

 - Monographs: (Petrie, 1931)

Bibliography:
Petrie, W.M.F., 1931. *Ancient Gaza I*, London.
- Groups of references should be listed first alphabetically, then chronologically.

BIBLIOGRAPHY: arrange the authors alphabetically and then further sorted chronologically if necessary. More than one reference from the same author(s) in the same year must be identified by the letters 'a', 'b', 'c', etc., placed after the year of publication.

Abbreviations

Please note that all **journals and series** have to be given in full quotation (see below).

Graphics:

- FIGURES: are accepted as files preferably as TIFF or similar format (PSD, EPS, AI) for PC.
- Resolution for line drawings: minimum 800 dpi (better 1200 dpi);
- Resolution for photographs: 300 dpi for black and white photographs in desired scale for publication (minimum). Good quality drawings and photographs are suitable.
- Please indicate the most appropriate place in the hard copy where the figures shall be inserted into the text.
- Provide Black and White illustrations (greyscale) as far as possible, colour illustrations cannot be guaranteed for print, but for the online pdf version.
- Print captions to the figures, tables or plates at separate sheets, and send them in a separate file.
- Illustrations must not exceed 18 x 24.3 cm (page) or 8,5 x 24.3 cm (column), respectively.
- Number the illustrations according to their sequence in the text.
- Submit each figure as a separate file.
- Provide captions to illustrations separately.

Tables

Number tables in accordance with their appearance in the text. Please avoid vertical rules.

PLEASE CHECK BEFORE SENDING:

- All figure captions, format of the figures (illustrations)
- All tables (including title, description, footnotes)
- Manuscript is 'spell-checked' and 'grammar-checked'
- All references mentioned in the text are in the Bibliography
- References are in the correct format
- Permission has been obtained for use of copyrighted material from other sources (including the Web)
